Dr. Babanna Hoovinabhavi, the chief Guest of the function, introduced the topic of National Education Policy 2020 and cited that it has four parts –

4. Make it Happen
And for non-teaching staff

 2. Forthcoming UUCMS

He said that in part II, Chapter 15 (Fifteen) deals with “Teacher Education” Due to many confusions and Complications, NCT has set up a special committee to study in detail the concept of Two (01) years and one year of B.Ed Course. He said, Integrated Teacher Education Programme is mandatory. The one (01) year course is a multiple entry, Two (01) is considered as a Diploma Course, Three year course will be the basic degree and Four year will be “Degree with honors”. In Multidisciplinary institutions, a student can study any two unrelated subject. Reconstructing of our curriculum has been made mandatory. By 2030, a Four year Teacher Education will be realized. NEP has a holistic approach and is value based policy.

There are five values

1. Truth
2. Righteousness conduct
3. Peace
4. Love and
5. Non-violence

Based on five domains of human personality

1. Intellectual level
2. Physical level
3. Educational level
4. Spiritual level
5. Psychological levels

All three are based on three objectives

1. Cognitive
2. Affective
3. Psycho – motor – skills

All Colleges and Universities should practice

1. Knowledge as creation
2. Knowledge as dissemination
3. Knowledge as application

All Three are interdependent.

NEP Skill are employ ability skills and do not assure employment.

All round development in NEP means value and skill Enhancement like vocational jobs, orientation course, NCC, NSS, Red Cross cell ports, and many such Socio-cultural courses hence forth will be made mandatory.

He summed up by starting the main objectives of NEP

1. Outcome based Education
2. Graduate Attributes
3. Pedagogy and its verities
4. Continuous Assessment
5. Experiential Learning

The NEP's Objectives can be realized if the policy is implemented as stato.

Shri Amarendra math, Lecture in Physics RECT introduced Guest of Honour – Dr.Ganapati B Sinnor Asst Professor, Dept of Business studies central university Kadaganchi Shri Sharad N Reshmi, Security, felicitated Dr.Ganapati.

Dr. Ganapati sir, said that “Teacher without B.Ed Education are Teachers without license”

He spoke at length about Situational Leadership.

As per the less of NEP 92% of teacher are unaware of NEP.

Topic - Communication and Soft Skills

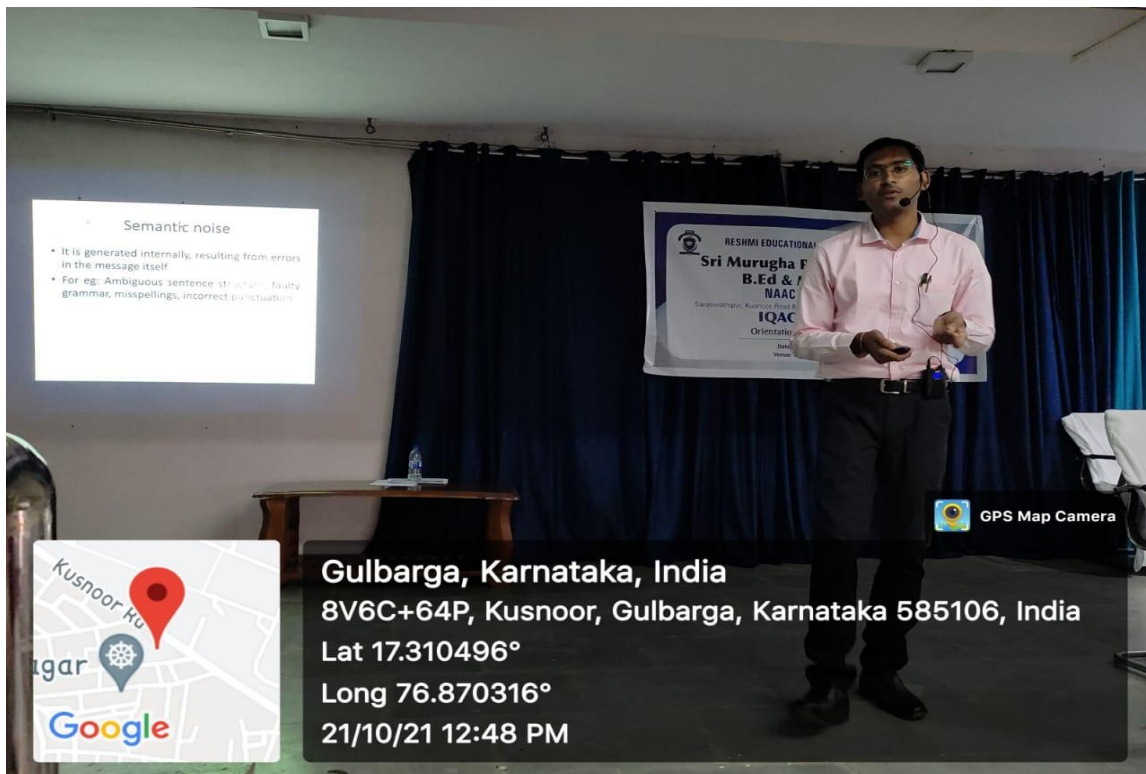
Prof. Ameeth Mashimade was introduced by Biradar sir and he was felicitated by S. Biradar

Dr. Vinodkumar was introduced by Miss.Shivani_ and He was felicitated by Dr.Rajashekhar Shirvalakar

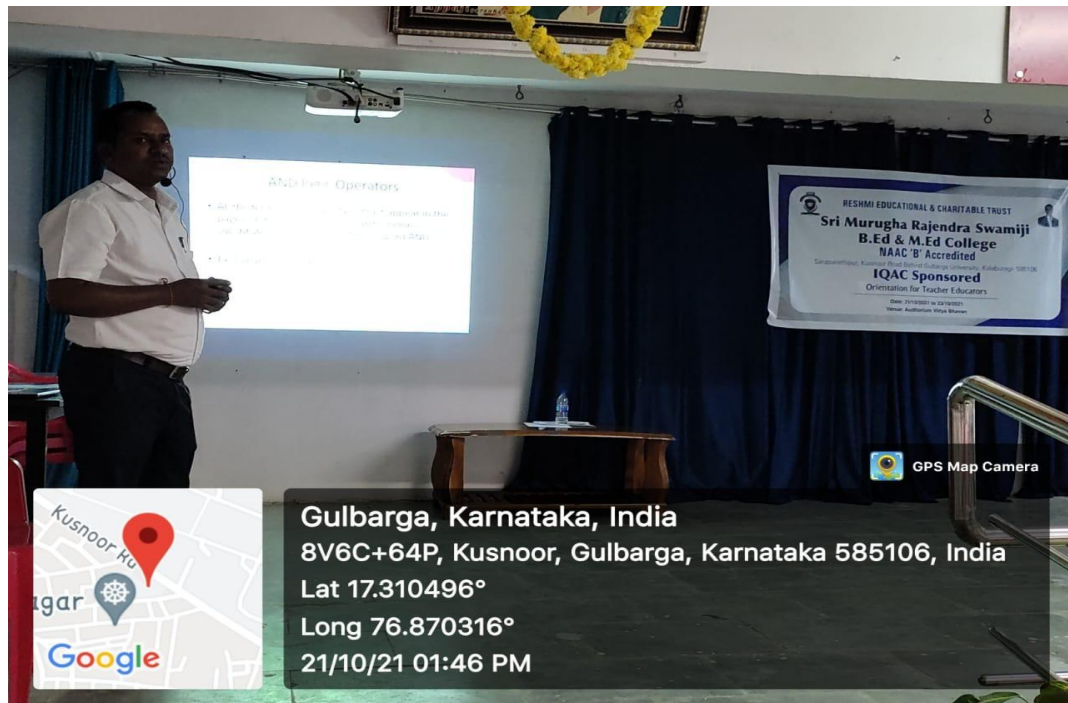
He said that Library today is working towards the changing system in information technologies. Material in digital format accessible.
